REACH Air Medical Services Relocates to Stockton Airport

SANTA ROSA, CA – December 4, 2009 – REACH Air Medical Services (REACH) announces the relocation of its Acampo base of operations from Lodi Airport to Stockton Airport. Emergency air transport services via helicopter began from the new location on December 1, 2009.

“The move from Acampo to Stockton is approximately 20 miles to the south and places our base in a more centralized location within San Joaquin County. The Stockton Airport has enhanced capabilities and is an ideal location to more efficiently serve our hospital and EMS partners,” says REACH Operations Base Manager, Kim Adams. REACH provides emergency air transport in response to 9-1-1 calls from regional EMS agencies as well as from hospitals requiring transport of critically ill or injured patients to specialized care at another location.

REACH, with headquarters in Santa Rosa, CA, has operated from a base in Lodi since 1995. Twelve REACH bases provide life-saving 24/7 emergency helicopter or airplane transport service to residents located throughout California, Oregon and southern Texas.
